

BE A CHANGEMAKER

Young Community Changemakers (YC2) is a leadership development program designed to educate and empower local youth to become our community's next generation of philanthropists — those who give their time, talent, treasure and ties for the common good. YC2 is sponsored by Community Memorial Foundation and designed around a shared vision that young people need opportunities to develop the skills to be future leaders and stewards of our community.

By joining YC2, you can make a positive impact in your community while teaming up with other high school students. You'll site visit local organizations, delve into community needs and grant money to important causes. Unlike other volunteer opportunities, YC2 puts the decision-making power into your hands, empowering you to be a changemaker in your community.









THE DETAILS

Sixty students from Hinsdale Central High School, Lyons Township High School, Riverside Brookfield High School and Nazareth Academy will be selected as Young Community Changemakers. Program curricula begins with students exploring social challenges in their community, and learning philanthropic theory and organizational evaluation.



Students will review grant applications from local organizations, conduct site visits, and at the end of the semester-long program, award up to \$30,000 to nonprofit organizations that further the mission and vision of Community Memorial Foundation.

A community celebration will be held on Wednesday, May 13, 2026 at Premier Countryside (6240 Joliet Rd.) from 4:30–6:00PM.
